



LISTENING TO PODCASTS AND FORMING SMALL GROUPS

Size

Small Groups should be no larger than about five parents or three couples. Small Groups are the backbone of Parents of Teens. They are the place where dads and moms begin to feel kinship with other parents because they each get a chance to talk and feel understood and supported by each other. It is in small groups where they can pray together if they so choose. Any larger group than 4-5 means that possibly someone will not get a chance to speak up during Small Group Time or possibly during the entire Parents of Teens class. Therefore, the goal is to keep the small groups a recommended size.

Preparing Ahead

You will be choosing 3-4 Small Group Questions from a Supplemental List given as a second page to each Agenda. Listening to the podcast ahead of time is vital. As you begin to know your parents and their individual home situations you will better be able to choose the Small Group Questions that best fit your parents and their needs.
